**Statement of Fact**

The Department of Education was awarded an Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief Fund grant (CFDA# 84.425D) in April 2020 through the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security (CARES) Act. Personal Services and related All Other allotment is needed to properly account for payroll charges based on work effort for 3 Regional Education Representative positions and one Education Specialist II position. These positions serve as two School Nurse Consultants who provide general pandemic related technical assistance and guidance to the field, a Data Quality Trainer who serves as a consultant and provides leadership and training on the data system and a Social-Emotional Learning Specialist who supports activities and interventions that respond to students' academic, social and emotional needs while addressing the impact of COVID-19 on underrepresented student groups.

Statement of Fact

This financial order allots a portion of the unencumbered balance forward to provide funding for the Childcare Infrastructure Grant Program. There are significant gaps in access to childcare in Maine because of the COVID-19 pandemic and increased inflation. The Childcare Infrastructure Grant Program will provide interested parties the tools to start a successful childcare business, help them refine their childcare/early childhood education philosophy and guide them through the licensing process. The population of children and families prioritized for assistance include rural communities, families needing infant or toddler childcare, low-income families using childcare subsidy payments, New Mainer communities and worksite-based programs like hospitals and schools. Increasing available and affordable childcare enables more parents to re-enter or stay in the workforce. Allotment was established for these services in fiscal year 2021-22 but due to delays, services were not provided.

**Statement of Fact**

This financial order transfers All Other to Personal Services to establish 2 limited-period Marine Resource Scientist I positions to assist with acoustic data analysis for the economic sustainability for the state fisheries project. Funds were authorized in Public Law 2021, chapter 483, An Act To Provide Allocations for the Distribution of State Fiscal Recovery Funds. The positions will start on January 17, 2023, and end on December 31, 2024. All Other funds are no longer needed for the purpose for which they were originally intended due to a change in the business plan. Failure to approve this order will result in the department's inability to supply needed management of the awarded American Rescue Plan Act funds.
